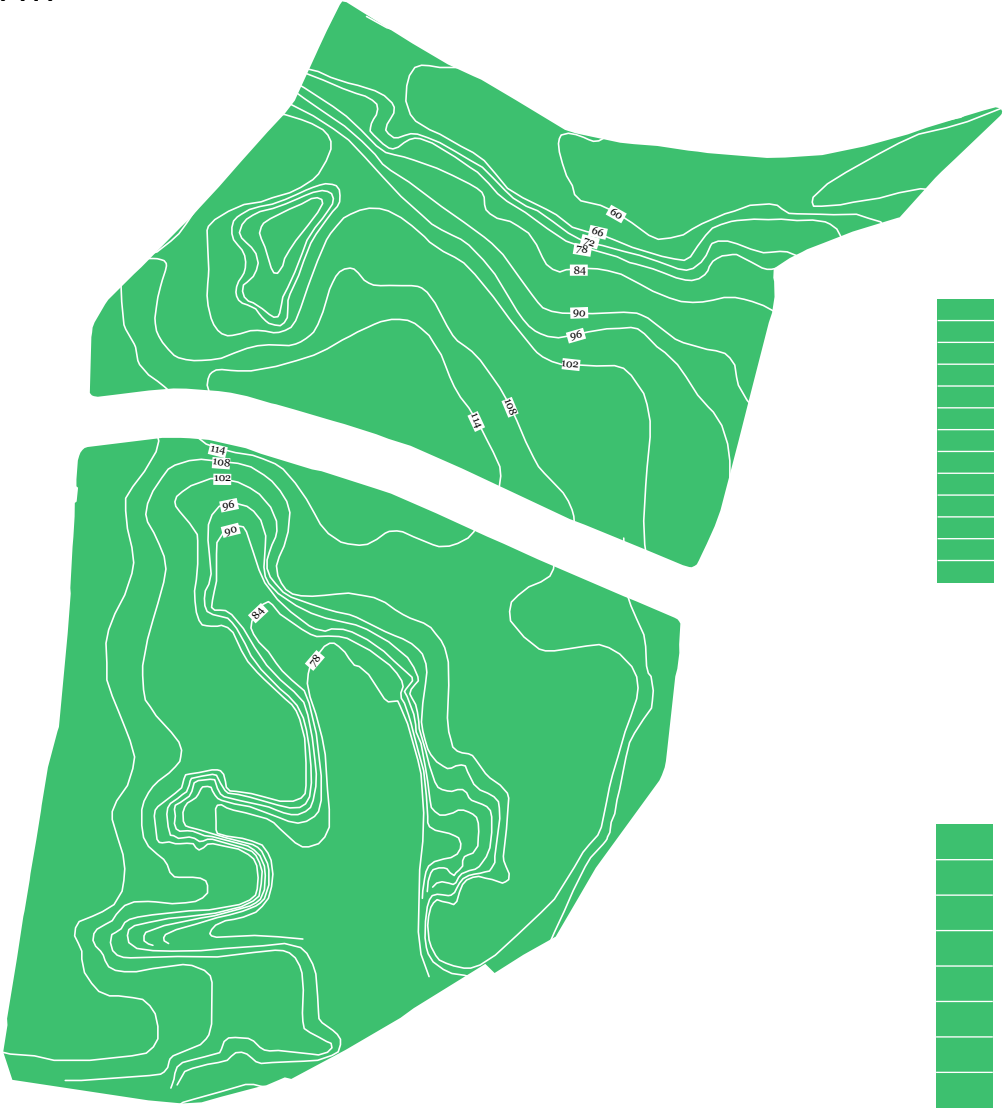




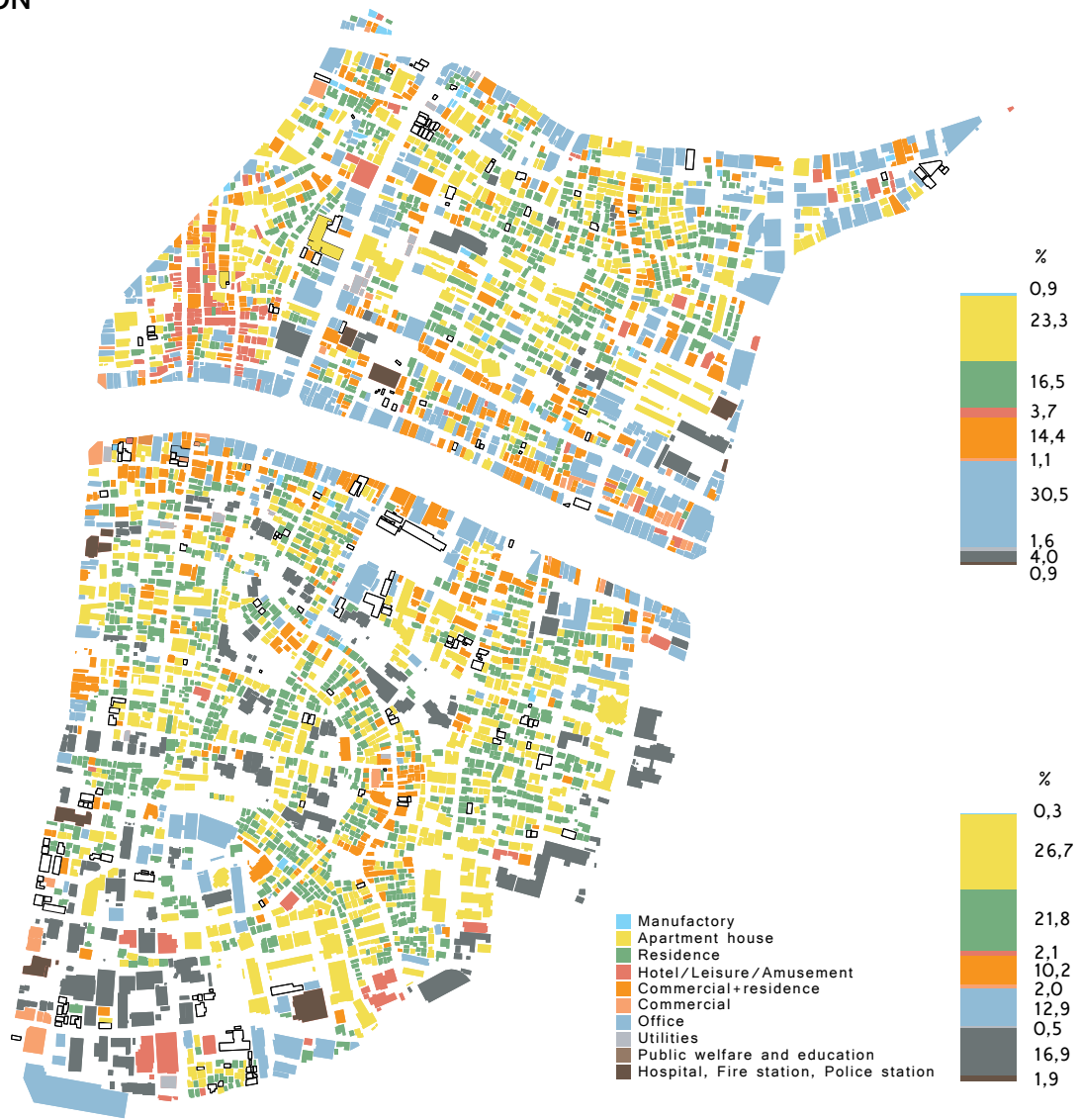

YOTSUYA MODERN MAP - NEW STREET PATTERNS



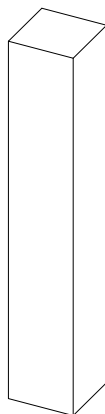

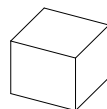

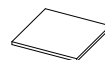

ADDRESS UNITS

The Japanese address system is based on units, not streets as in Western standards. This classification also refers to governmental institutions within the city.

Example of an address:

Tōkyō-to	(city)
Shinjuku-ku	(ward)
Yotsuya-machi	(district)
1-Chōme	(city block)
5-ban	(block)
3-gō	(building)
